An Awareness Programme on the Admission Process for the academic session 2025–26 was successfully organised by Haji Anfar Ali College on 5th May 2025 at the Smart Classroom (Room No. 25). The programme was primarily targeted at Higher Secondary passed-out students and their guardians, aiming to provide comprehensive guidance on the admission process.

The event was presided over by Dr. Mamun Azam Barbhuiya, Principal of the college, and was anchored by Dr. Hasinus Sultan, Admission Module Coordinator. The programme witnessed an overwhelming participation of around 200 admission aspirants along with their guardians.





In his presidential address, Dr. Mamun Azam Barbhuiya briefed the gathering on the admission guidelines issued by the Directorate of Higher Education (DHE), Assam. He also informed the participants about the Fee Waiver Scheme of the Government of Assam for eligible applicants.

A key highlight of the programme was a live demonstration conducted by Mr. Tayebur Rahman, Guest Faculty of Computer Education. Using the Digital Panel Board, he demonstrated the step-by-step process of registration on the SAMARTH Portal, launched by the Government of Assam, covering important sections such as filling up details, uploading necessary documents, and selecting colleges and courses.

After the formal programme, participants visited various college facilities including the Central Library, Computer Lab, Auditorium, and the Indoor Stadium, which helped them gain a better understanding of the institutional infrastructure.
